Cancer Research UK (CRUK) is the world's largest independent cancer research charity, dedicated to funding research into the prevention, diagnosis, and treatment of cancer, as well as providing information and influencing policy. It was formed in 2002 from the merger of The Cancer Research Campaign and the Imperial Cancer Research Fund.

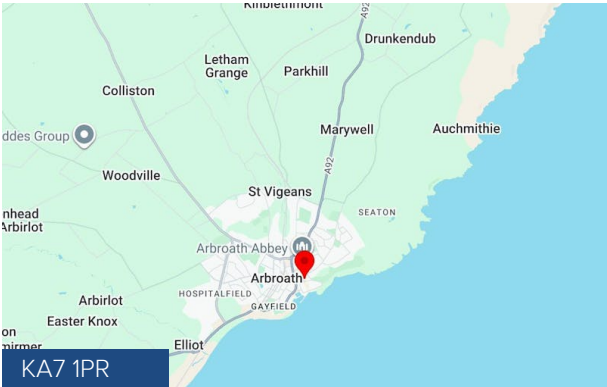
As of late 2025, CRUK operates around 600 shops and superstores across the UK. In the financial year 2024/25, CRUK reported total income of £735 million, its highest-ever figure. CRUK employs over 4,000 paid staff, this excludes tens of thousands of volunteers (e.g, over 17,500 in shops alone), who play a crucial role in operations.

Location

The property is situated on the west side of High Street within Ayr town centre.

Ayr is a popular coastal market town with a population of circa 46,000 persons and is the principal commercial town in Ayrshire benefiting from excellent transport links.
